#### - 1

■ Need to clarify which markets NFC Forum want to promote the tap mark


NO: Payment and transportation markets uses service platform mark (1)(2)

NO: Access control market do not use NFC mark because card and Reader are designated

NO: Handset manufacturers do not try to put a tap mark on the smartphone

Design-Independent issues

YES: IoT markets such as consumer products, vehicle and NFC tag(3) often use NFC mark to appear the technology

- How the mark should be for the IoT market
  - > Simple design is needed since the mark tend to be small one
  - > Same mark has been used for task bar, instruction manual, etc. to be easily understood by end users
    - \* N-Mark is a technology mark like Bluetooth and Wi-Fi mark



#### **OBSERVATION**

#### - 3

- Impact to the current adopters of N-Mark
  - > It is common to switch the mark when the generations change. Only switching design makes strong impact on current adopters since it will simply cause confusion regarding interoperability.
    - As a standards body, rationale is needed.
  - > Auto vehicle industry, and even consumer product industry need long grace period for transition






