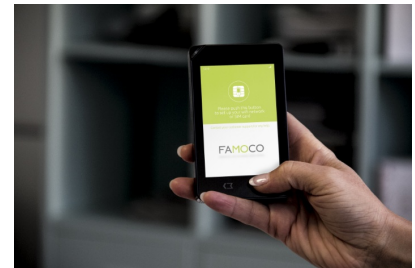

Technical Update



In January 2017, the NFC Forum published a white paper which describes the methodology, procedures and results for comparing Analog Parameter among ISO/IEC 14443, ISO/IEC 18092 and NFC Forum specifications. The white paper was based on the publication of the NFC Forum Analog 2.0 Technical Specification, which ensures that NFC Forum Devices are fully interoperable with components compliant to the ISO/IEC 14443 or ISO/IEC 18092 specification. This interoperability is essential for a successful integration of public transport ticketing solutions on NFC Forum devices. The NFC Forum worked together with GSMA, East Japan Railways, CEN TC278 WG3 and the Smart Ticketing Alliance to provide this basis for mobile ticket solutions. In March 2017, GlobalPlatform, ETSI SCP and NFC Forum published a joint white paper for a standardized management of NFC services on NFC-enabled devices. This white paper describes how NFC services from different service providers on one NFC-enabled device can be managed in a transparent way for the end user. This concept shows that multiple NFC applications can coexist even on different secure elements (e.g. UICC plus embedded secure element) by resolving possible conflicts between these NFC applications.
